TOPIC: **Kaawaate East City Public School Accommodation Planning Update**

BACKGROUND

1. The Kaawaate East City Public School Accommodation Planning report was presented to the Resource Committee on November 8, 2023. The report explained the accommodation pressures being experienced at this school site and provided a timeline for reviewing the proposed accommodation measure presented to address the urgent and immediate needs.
2. Kaawaate East City Public School (PS) is experiencing significant accommodation pressure with an anticipated enrolment of 785 (1phased in this school year (2024/25)

RECOMMENDATION

1. That Kaawaate East City Public School be established as a Junior Kindergarten to Grade 6 dual-track school, and Grades 7 to 8 English stream. That Grades 7 to 8 French Immersion students from Kaawaate East City Public School attend Adam Scott Intermediate School, effective September 2024.
