When will the Pupil Accommodation Review pause be lifted?

Since June 2017, the Ministry of Education has put a 'pauste'eo Paupil Accommodation Reviewprocess, which means that school closure and/or consolidations cannot be considered as options to address enrolment, programming or facility challenges. We have not received any indicationabout whenthe pause will be lifted.

Why was the new school build request denied by the Ministry of Education?

The Ministry of Education funds a limited number poofjects each year, based doudget and priorities. Capital funding to support new schools, replacement schools, additions and deep retrofits to existing schools is allocated by the provincial government through the Capital Priorities program, an annual process where school boards identify their most ungeint p accommodation needs.

The Ministry has a fixed capital budget that they allocate to school boards based on their assessment of where the greatest priorities lie across the province. In their review process, the Ministry assigns a higher priority toojects where utilization rates are equal to or greater than 100% at all nearby schools, as well as to those where the need for additional pupil places is demonstrable within the neaterm as opposed to longerm accommodation pressures. At this time, the Board has available pupil places at Clarke High School.

How many rooms are empty at each school?

All the rooms at Newcastle PS and The Pinerio SPS are currently being utilized. Clarke HS has several empty rooms, mostly on the 20 or.

Why not use Bowmanville HS for Clarke HS secondary students, Clarke as an intermediate school and The Pines as an elementary school?
