APPARATUS FOR TRANSPORTING STUDENTS

This administrative regulation is written in accordance with the guiding principles in Board Policy No. <u>BA8.6</u>, <u>Transportation</u>: <u>Student Safety</u>

- 1. The Board offers transportation to students within the System, for a number of programs and using a variety of vehicles including:
 - 1.1 full size school buses e.g. 66, 72 passenger;
 - 1.2 smaller vehicles 20 passenger;
 - 1.3 wheelchair accessible vehicles;
 - 1.4 taxis, as equired for special circumstances; and
 - 1.5 vehicles with adult bus monitors.
- From time totime, vehicles must be adapted in order to provide the safest possible environment for the special high needs pupil, others riding the same vehicle, for the driver, and the general public.
- 3. Parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be advised that their son/daughter/foster child will be transported using a special apparatus (e.g. 4 point harnwass, cars and miwans). Harnesses and restraining vests are to be used to support mobility impaired individuals and are not designed for students with behavioural challenges.
- 4. Parent(s)/guardian(s) shall acknowledge, in writing, that they understand and agree to the use of the special apparatus to ensure the safety octive while being transported by the Board.
- 5. If this acknowledgment is not received in writing, responsibility for transporting the student shall rest with the legal guardian.
- 6. The standardized form, Special Apparatus, Acknowledgment of Understailsdinge completed by parent(s)/guardian(s).
