6. POLICY

- 6.1 Display of National and Provincial Flags
 - 6.1.1 All schools shall display inside the school both the National Flag of Canadændthe Provincial Flag of Ontario, as required by Ontario Regulation 298.
 - 6.12 The National Flag must be given prominence at all times and should be placedon the left of the other flags (to the right of the dais) when standards are useld.three flags are displayed, the National Flag should be placed in the middle.
 - 6.1.3 KPR schools are equipped with one exteribing pole per schools such, our schools ensure that the National Flag is given primacy of position at all times. This is maintained throughout the year when our schools also fly the Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board flag.
- 6.2 Lowering Flags

Exterior flags throughout theystem shall be lowered to half-mast on the deathof:

- 6.22 the Sovereign or a member of the Royal Family related in the first degree to the Sovereign (husband or wife, son or daughter, father, mother,brother or sister);
- 6.2.3 the Governor-general or a former Governor-general, the Prime Minister of Canada or a former Prime Minister;
- 6.2.4 The Lieutenangovernor of Ontario or a former Lieutenant governor;
- 6.2.5 the Premier of Ontario or a former Premier;
- 6.2.6 the Chairperson or member of the Boafd rustees

In addition:

- 6.2.7 on the death of a Member of the House of Common Perovincial Legislature for that riding;
- 6.2.8 flags at schools within a specific municipality shall be lowered to half-maston the death of a Senator whose residence is in that

6.2.9 principalsmay lower flags to halfnast on the death of any person held in

At the discretion of the *n*prcipal schools may also flyhe Pride flag during other times in the school year.
