

- 1.2.1 Student Trusteewill have the right to participate in discussions at all open and incamera session meetings of Board and committees, with the following exception: Student Trustee not permitted to attend-imamera sessions of either the Board or Board committee meetings when the subject matter under consideration involves the disclosure of intimate, personfithemicial information in respect of a member of the Board or a pupilsoor her parent or guardian.
- 1.2.2 Student Trusteseare not entitled to move a motion, but are entitled to suggest a motion on any matter at a Boardborroittee meeting on which the Student Trustee sits. If no member of the Boardborroittee, as the case may be, moves the suggested motion, the record shall show the suggested motion.
- 1.2.3 Student Trustee not Boad member and therefore not entitled to a binding vote.
- 1.2.4 A Student Trustee has the right to have their **biond**ing vote recorded in the Board Minutes if she or **hrequess** it.

- 5.2.1.1 Students would be responsible to the committee chairperson and would be expected to attend committee meetings regularly.
- 5.2.1.2 The student shall notify the office of the committee administrative resource person if the student is unable to attend a meeting.
- 5.2.1.3 The student will not count for quorum.
- 5.2.1.4 In the case of irregular attendance or any breach of conduct, the committee chairperson will refer the matter to the Student Leadership Group.
- 6. Student Trustee Resources
 - 6.1 The Vicechairperson of the Board, or designate, will act as a Studestee Mentor to Student Trustse
 - 6.1.1 The designation of Student Trustee Mentor shall be made by the Chairperson of the Board in consultation with the Student Trustee, the Trustee being considered, and the Director of Education.
 - 6.1.2 Existing Student Trusteewill be asked to play a role in orientating the in-coming Student Trustee representative to the Board.
 - 6.2 Once elected, the Board will provide Student Trussweith an orientation package.
 - 6.2.1 The Board will provide Student Trueses with a resource list of federation and union representatives, senior administration, Trustees and representatives of nournion groups.
 - 6.3 The Board shall reimburse Student Tru**stee** expenses while on approved Board business in accordance with Board policy.
 - 6.4 The Board will provide Student Trusteerith reasonable access to resources for the purpose of fulfilling the duties, including a computer, a cell phone,-moiside and enail.

7. Recognition for Student Trustes

Student Trusteewill receive an honorarium based on Ministry funding for the term August 1 to July 31. If Student Trustee does not serve for a full term, then the amount is prorated. AStudent Trustee may earn up to two independent study credits.

7.1 A Student Leadership Group advisor shall monitor the position and make a recommendation to the principal of the school the student attends.

The Board will provide documentation to the Student Trustee, and the student home school, referencing the Student Trusteentributions.
